

FY2019 JSCE Awards Application Guidelines

International Lifetime Contribution Award

International Outstanding Collaboration Award

1. International Lifetime Contribution Award

Nominee Criteria*

Nominee should:

- i.** Demonstrate outstanding contribution to the development and advancement of Japanese civil engineering.
- ii.** Show evidence of building and/or enhancing technical knowledge, skills and experiences mutually beneficial to both Japanese and their overseas counterparts and improving cooperation and collaboration between them.

*the criteria is applicable only for foreign candidates.

2. International Outstanding Collaboration Award (Est. in 2013)

Nominee Criteria

Nominee should:

- i.** Be around 50 years old or younger on April 1, 2020.
- ii.** Demonstrate great contribution to the improvement and advancement of Japanese civil engineering, and/or the development of infrastructure in Japan and/or overseas through technical exchange, cooperation and collaboration between Japanese civil engineers and their overseas counterparts.
- iii.** Show high-level commitment to the civil engineering profession and excellent leadership qualities which inspire his/her colleagues and juniors in Japan and overseas to motivate and achieve their goals.

*This award considers only foreign civil engineering professionals.

3. Others

Nominee is not limited to JSCE Member. Any who meets the aforementioned criteria is eligible to receive the awards.

Nominees' performances and achievements made by December 31, 2019 will be given consideration for the awards.

4. Nomination

- i.** Self-nomination is not be taken into consideration
- ii.** A nomination is considered valid if it is submitted by the persons who fall within one of the following categories:
 - JSCE Honorary Member
 - Fellow Member
 - Corporate Member
 - Special Member
 - JSCE International Section Member, and
 - JSCE's Agreement of Cooperation Society

Note: In case that nomination is made by an organization, society, institute and the like, their top leadership must submit the nomination for that body.

- iii. One nominator nominates only one candidate per award.
- iv. Nominator has to use the required nomination form and submit it by the deadline.
- v. Nominator may provide reference materials which can prove and describe candidate's eligibility for the award. The reference materials must be submitted in PDF, CD, DVD, or flush drive.

5. Selection Process

JSCE Award Selection Committee will screen all candidates with the nomination letter and documents submitted by the deadline January 20, 2020 and select award recipients

6. JSCE Awards Ceremony

The award recipients will be invited to the awards ceremony for official presentation of awards which is held during FY2019 JSCE General Assembly. The International Lifetime Contribution Award and International Outstanding Collaboration Award recipients will receive a plaque and certificate at the ceremony.

FY2019 JSCE General Assembly is held in Tokyo on Friday, June 12, 2020.

7. Nomination Deadline

Friday, January 20, 2020, Japan time.

Nominations for the International Lifetime Contribution Award and International Outstanding Collaboration Award shall be sent in to the JSCE Awards Selection Committee in the JSCE Headquarters in Tokyo, Japan.
